Application and Selection

These notes apply to school experience (SE) offered at Maiden Erlegh School. If you seek experience at another Maiden Erlegh Teaching School Alliance partner, please contact that school.

We are no longer using **getintoteaching**'s School Experience Programme (SEP) portal to offer places. Instead, you should complete and submit our application form.

School experience in 2016-17 at this school will be offered to those who intend to apply for School Direct Initial Teacher Training (ITT) at this school for 2017-18 entry and who meet our eligibility criteria.

Places are limited and subject to availability. We will offer up to **five** days per successful participant.

Participant selection will be made periodically according to eligibility and assessment of applications received. We will notify you of the outcome of your application and, if successful, we will then agree dates with you.

Your ID will be checked on your first day of attendance at this school.

Subjects

School experience observing teaching and learning at this school is offered in 2016-17 in the subjects in which we have School Direct ITT places at this school in 2017-18:

- Biology, chemistry, physics, maths, geography, English, French, German, Spanish (KS3), physical education, business studies

Eligibility

To be eligible for school experience at this school you must:

- Complete and submit our school experience application form
- Intend to apply to Maiden Erlegh Teaching School Alliance, 1Y1, for School Direct ITT 2017-18 entry in one of the above subjects.
- Have maths and English GCSE at grade C or above
- Have three good A-levels including one in the subject you wish to teach
- Have, or expect to have by summer 2017, a minimum of a 2:2 in a UK honours degree in a subject which is closely related to the subject you wish to teach.
- Have or expect to have a UK NARIC statement of comparability if you have equivalent non-UK qualifications
